

NEED TO GET YOUR HUNTING OR FISHING LICENSE?

Conservation Licenses may be purchased at the Town Clerk's office located at 6560 Dysinger Road during regular business hours. You can contact the Clerk's office at 439-9524 with any questions prior to your visit. To purchase a hunting license you must have completed the proper hunter safety course and present your certificate. Please visit www.dec.gov for any further information or clarification.

You need a hunting license if you are:

- 12 years and older and using a firearm or bow to hunt or take wild game. Persons under age 12 cannot hunt
- Annual hunting licenses and privileges are valid from September 1 through August 31 each year.

• All licensed hunters 12 and older can apply for deer permits as well.

You need a fishing license if you are 16 years and older

 Fishing licenses do not require a training course and expire one year from date of purchase or renewal.

INCOME LIMIT CHANGE FOR ENHANCED STAR

If you are currently receiving the BASIC STAR EXEMPTION, and will be turning 65 by December 31, 2026, you could be eligible for ENHANCED STAR.

The income limit for the 2026-2027 school tax year is \$110,750, as verified by the 2024 Federal or State Income Tax Return. Income is Adjusted Gross MINUS any Taxable IRA Distributions.

CHANGES:

You NO longer apply at the Assessor's Office. NYS Dept of Taxation and Finance will notify you and the Assessor's Office if you qualify for an Enhanced STAR exemption. (Currently, this is all the information we have.)

If NYS needs more information to determine your eligibility, such as in cases of someone who does not file an income tax return, then they (NYS) will send a letter requesting information. They will not call you.

If you are receiving the STAR CREDIT (a check from NYS), the State will be checking for age and income to verify your qualification.

NOTE FROM BUILDING INSPECTOR

Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Detector: Now is a good time to replace batteries in smoke and carbon monoxide detectors going into the fall and winter season. Smoke/CO detectors should be replaced after 10 years of use with new 10-year battery smoke/CO detectors.

Fire Hydrants: Fire Code of NYS: A 3 foot clear space shall be maintained around the circumference of a fire hydrant.

Open Burning NYSDEC: Open Burning is permitted for small recreational fires including small cooking and campfires.

Burning of waste products or garbage is prohibited, including newspaper, paper products, plastic, chemically treated wood (pressure treated) and plywood. If you have a complaint regarding this, please contact the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation AT 1-877-457-5680. They are available 24/7

Photo flashback, circa 1963



The Ames Discount Department Store opened in the Town of Lockport on August 20, 1963, with much fanfare. They advertised it was "completely air-conditioned" with free parking for 500 cars. There were 55 departments and 74 employees. The amenities caught the eye of burglars who broke in after opening day and stole \$10,000. This was just the sixth Ames store to open in the country. At its peak, the region had over 700 stores. Tops and Ames were located on the west side of Transit Road, approximately where Home Depot is now.

Highway Department



BRUSH PICK-UP: Brush pick up will continue the third Monday of October and November. Please have your brush out by Sunday night. We pick up throughout the whole town. If you don't have it out by the time we come around, you will have to wait until the next month. **Please refer to our guidelines on our website at elockport.gov under highway department.**

REFUSE/RECYCLING: Please have your garbage and recycling out by 6 am. If it isn't picked up by 2 pm, call the highway clerk at 439-9522.

BAGS OF GARBAGE: If you have bags which are over forty pounds, Modern will pick them up during large item pick up. If they are less than forty pounds, you will need to purchase stickers at the town clerk's office for \$5/each.

BULK PICK UP: Modern Disposal will pick up 4 large items during the first full week of each month. If they don't take it with the regular garbage truck, please be patient and they will come back with another truck. This includes any carpet/flooring/wood planks you may have.

MAILBOXES: If your mailbox is hit by a snowplow, please call the highway office at 439-9522. We will replace it with a standard mailbox, no exceptions. If you live on a county road and your mailbox is hit, please call the county at 439-7360. If you live on a state road, please call NYSDOT at 438-2396.

LAST CHANCE FOR ELECTRONICS RECYCLING FOR 2025!

Come on out to see us on **Saturday, October 25th** to get those electronics properly recycled. This is your last opportunity for the year, **otherwise you'll need to hold on to these items until April of 2026**. As you know, this event is held right at Town Hall from 9 am – 1 pm. No need to get out of the vehicle, just pull up and we will do the rest.

Recycling electronics costs the town up to 9 cents a pound. Since we are not charging a fee for this service, we are limiting usage strictly to **Town of Lockport Residents** (please be prepared to show ID).

The hours of operation for the Town of Lockport Recycling Shed are: The last Saturday of each month, 9:00 AM - 1:00 PM, April through October.

NO after hour drop-offs will be permitted. Cameras are in place to protect and enforce the program.


