

From the Desk of the Supervisor

I would like to take this opportunity to give the residents an overview of what happened in your town in 2025

- Town Hall & Community Center: Our Town Hall has undergone a complete update, and we will also be opening our new Community Center in January 2026. These projects were both accomplished with available funds so no additional debt was incurred.
- Highway Department: This year marked a record amount of paving, improving roads across our community.
- Water Department: Significant progress was made with waterline replacements, including Locust Street Ext and sections of Transit Road. The remainder of Locust St Ext and portions of Hamm Road will be completed in early 2026.
- Day Road Park: We continued enhancing recreational spaces with the addition of brand-new pickleball courts.

None of these achievements would have been possible without the dedicated work of our loyal Town of Lockport employees. Their commitment and service to the town are the foundation of our success.

Looking ahead, 2026 promises to be another outstanding year for our town, with more projects and improvements on the horizon. Together, we are building a stronger, more vibrant Lockport.

AMERICA'S STAIRWAY

America's Stairway places the historic Flight of Five locks on the Erie Canal in Lockport, New York, squarely in the American narrative as a symbol of what a young and developing nation could achieve. It draws a direct line from the Flight of Five to the birth of American tourism and today's heritage tourism industry, which is inextricably linked to grassroots preservation efforts and a community's pride

and sense of place. In doing so, this is a story that resonates beyond time and geographic location. The film also explores how the Erie Canal served as a conduit for new ideas and reform movements.

REFUSE/RECYCLING: Please have your garbage and recycling totes out by 6 am. If it is not picked up by 2 pm, call the highway clerk, 439-9522. Please remember Modern only has the following holidays off: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas.

BAGS OF GARBAGE: If you have bags which are over forty pounds, Modern will pick them up during large item pick up. If they are less than forty pounds, you will need to purchase stickers at the town clerk's office for \$5/each.



BULK PICK UP: Modern Disposal will pick up four bulk items during the first full week of each month. If they do not take it with the regular garbage truck, please be patient and they will come back with another truck. This



includes any carpet/flooring/wood planks you may have. (See schedule in this newsletter)

MAILBOXES: If your mailbox is hit by a snowplow, please call the highway office, 439-9522. We will replace it with a standard mailbox, no exceptions. If you live on a county road, please call the county at 439-7360. If you live on a state road, please call NYSDOT at 438-2396. The Town of Lockport Highway does not plow county and state roads.

BRUSH: Brush pick up is the third Monday of the month: March, April, May, June, September, October & November. We will not pick up brush in July & August. Please have everything out by Sunday night. We pick up throughout the town. Once we are in your neighborhood, we will not be back until the following month.

Assessor and Building Inspector News

Annual Re-Assessment Program

The Town of Lockport is continuing on its 25th year of annual re-assessment, to maintain its equalization level at 100% of market value. All properties in the Town are analyzed. Any changes are determined by **recent sale** information.

Change of Assessment Notices are mailed around the first week of April. Any physical changes to the property, including additions, garages, pole barns, sheds, decks and demolition of structures may also affect the assessments.



Please review these notices. Informal meetings with the assessor are available in April, by appointment. Formal challenges to the assessments can be scheduled for the Board of Assessment Review on or before, Tuesday, May 26, 2026, by appointment.

FROM THE ASSESSORS' OFFICE – Exemption Information

You may be eligible to receive partial exemption from your property taxes if you meet the following criteria:

- You are now, or are turning 65 years old, this year – OR –
- Are a person with a certified disability – AND –
- Your total taxable income for 2024 (including Social Security wages) is below \$34,600
- You reside on the property, as your primary residence

You may also be eligible for Veteran Exemptions if you served in active duty (does not include training, Reserves or National Guard)

Applications must be received by 3/1/2026.

Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Detector: Now It's a new year! Time to think about what you have in your home for safety. Smoke/CO detectors should be replaced after 10 years of use with new 10 year battery units.

Keep Entrances/Exits Clear: Particularly in the winter months, please be sure to keep all of your exit/entrance doorways and sidewalks clear of snow and ice for your safety as well any EMS personnel, visitors or delivery people.

NYS Electrical Mandate Clarification: At this time, New York State has paused the electrical mandate eliminating gas and propane installations. As soon as we know more, we will pass on the information.


