






While researching Johnson Road, formerly known as Baldwin Road, I came across a notice published in 1870 by our town's tax collector, Eleazer Baldwin.

From the Dog Control Officer

Just a reminder, it is most important that dog owners be aware of the Town of Lockport Code sections which adhere to dog control as follows:

TOWN OF LOCKPORT CODE

§ 80-4 LICENSING AND IDENTIFICATION

Any person owning, harboring or having care, custody or charge of any dog shall, at all times, be in full compliance with the obligations established pursuant to Agriculture and Markets Law §§ 109, relating to licensing, and 111, relating to identification of dogs.

§ 80-3 RUNNING AT LARGE PROHIBITED

No person owning, harboring or having care, custody or charge of any dog shall allow or permit such dog to run at large in the Town of Lockport unless effectively restricted or controlled by a person by means of a leash not exceeding 15 feet in length.



ATTENTION DOG OWNERS!!

TOWN OF LOCKPORT DOG ENUMERATION

As required by Article 7 of the New York State Agriculture and Markets Law, **any dog 4 months of age or older** must be licensed in the local Town they are sheltered in.

If your dog's license is current, no further action is required. For unlicensed dogs, please fill out the form below and return it with the required information:

1. Updated rabies certification from veterinarian
2. Spay or neuter certificate
3. Check payable to "Lockport Town Clerk"

The fees for licensing per dog are as follows:

1. Spayed/Neutered **\$8.00**
2. Unspayed/Unneutered **\$18.00**

Following the enumeration, an additional house to house follow-up may be performed, at which time an additional enumeration fee of \$25.00 will be added for unlicensed dogs, please contact the Town Clerk's office 716-439-9524 with any questions.

Highway Department



We WILL NOT pick up any brush in JULY AND AUGUST so that we can focus on roadwork.

Brush pick up is the third Monday of each month. The weeks are: April 20th, May 18th and June 15th. Please have your brush out by Sunday night. We pick up throughout the town. Once we are in your neighborhood, we won't be back until the following month. The following rules will be enforced for the town wide brush pick up:

- Tree removal companies are to remove all of their own debris
- A maximum amount of one tandem truckload will be picked up at a time at any one residence.
- No brush will be picked up that is stacked around hydrants, guardrails, vent pipes, signs, or any obstacle. We will not be responsible for anything under the pile of brush that we cannot see. Large piles are picked up with large machinery.

Refuse/Recycling: Please have your garbage/recycling out to the road by 6 am. If you have any questions, please call the highway office at 439-9522.

Bulk Week: It is the first full week of the month and you can put out up to 4 large items (furniture, mattresses, box spring for example). If a holiday falls on the first Monday of the month, large item pick up will be the following week. For example, Labor Day is Monday, September 7th. Therefore, large item pick up week will be the week of September 14th

Mailboxes: If your mailbox is damaged from our plow, please call the highway office at 439-9522. We will replace it with a black metal mailbox. If you live on a county road please call the county at 439-7360. If you live on a state road please call the state at 438-2396. We DO NOT plow county and state roads.

TOWN OF LOCKPORT ELECTRONICS RECYCLING SHED REOPENS IN APRIL!

I know it's not nearly as exciting as when the paving list comes out, but...it's nearly time for the electronics recycling shed to open for the season! With that said, I would like to answer a few of the common questions we get while working these events.

What do you accept at the event?

Think of going into the electronics section of a big box store. What do you see? TVs, DVD players, computers, monitors, laptops, cell phones right? These are the things we are looking to recycle. See the list below for details...

What do you NOT accept at this event?

Household appliances such as vacuums, stick vacuums, microwaves, fans, hair dryers, toasters and the like. These items should be put out on your regular garbage day for Modern to take. The recycle company does not find value in the minimal electronic components in these items. Also, NO BATTERIES of any type.

The hours of operation for the Town of Lockport Recycling Shed are: *The last Saturday of each month, 9:00 AM - 1:00 PM, April through October.* NO after

hour drop-offs will be permitted. Cameras are in place to protect and enforce the program. This event is open to Town of Lockport residents only (please be prepared to show ID).

NOTE FROM BUILDING INSPECTOR

Burning Ban: The start of Spring in New York comes with an increased risk of wildfires. For this reason, there is a burning ban in all of NYS from **March 16th, 2026 until May 14th, 2026**. NYS prohibits residential brush burning to protect our communities and natural resources. If you would like to report a violation, please contact the NYS DEC directly at 1-877-457-5680. There are representatives to take your call 24 hours a day.

Backyard fire pits and campfires: Less than 3 feet in height and four feet in length, width or diameter are allowed along with small cooking fires. Only charcoal or dry, clean, untreated, or unpainted wood can be burned.

Permit Requirements: Permits are required for ALL swimming pools, home backup generators, roofing and deck projects. Applications can be obtained at the Building Department located at 6200 Robinson Rd or visit our website at www.elockport.gov for more information along with access to the applications.




