NOTE FROM BUILDING INSPECTOR

NYSDEC: Open burning is permitted for small recreational fires including small cooking and campfires. Burning of waste products or garbage is prohibited, including newspaper, paper products, plastic, chemically treated wood (pressure treated) and plywood. Complaints call NYS DEC @ 1-877-457-5680. They are available 24/7

Swimming Pool Fencing & Alarm Requirements: NYS mandates that ALL swimming pools, residential or commercial, permanent or temporary (blue soft sided) are required to be in fenced enclosures 48” high and equipped with audible alarm.

Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Detectors: older than 10 years should be replaced with a new version with a 10 year battery backup. All removable batteries should be replaced with new ones.

2026 FREE RABIES IMMUNIZATION CLINICS



Clinic registration is required. Walk-ins will not be accepted.

Cat and dog owners are asked to bring proof of previous rabies vaccination in order to receive a certificate valid for three years. Ferret owners and pet owners without proof of vaccination will receive a certificate that is valid for one year.

All pets must be at least **3 months of age**.

Please keep animals on a **non-retractable leash** or in a **carrier**.

From the Desk of the Deputy Supervisor

Capital Improvement Project Update

Summer has finally arrived here in the 716! Our Town campus on Dysinger Road has undergone a series of construction renovations. The "town hall", which was originally built in 1974, was in need of some updates. The building now has a new façade, new entranceways and windows, along with additional office space on the existing footprint. Landscaping improvements will be added in the coming months. The recent renovations have modernized the facility to better serve the residents of our growing town, and it is something we all can be proud of.

The second phase consisted of renovating an existing building (formerly known as the Carpenters Union building) which was purchased by the town in 2011. The building is now called "Town Center" which comprises the Town of Lockport Industrial and Economic Development offices, along with our Community & Recreation Center. I encourage our residents to stop by and visit to see the changes. I'm confident that you will be pleased with what you see.

Infrastructure improvements also continue in the town with the installation of a new 10-inch PVC waterline on Hamm Road and Locust Street. This replaces the 70-year-old 6-inch cast iron

waterline that has had numerous waterline breaks in the past few years.

I also wanted to remind our town residents that the New York State Department of Transportation is modifying South Transit Road. This construction project involves the entire length of South Transit Road from Tonawanda Creek heading north to Dorchester Road. The project consists of milling and repaving this entire stretch. This will be a day and night project which will include new traffic signals, pedestrian safety improvements, and additional sidewalks. Traffic in these two areas will be severely impacted this summer. Please exercise caution and patience while traveling in this area. The safety of the work crews involved and our residents depends on the alertness of all. Drive safe, be safe, all tragic events are not only shared by the victims, but by their families who also suffer.

Highway Department



There will be NO BRUSH PICKUP for the months of July and August so that our highway crews can focus on paving and ditching projects throughout the town. Brush pick up will resume on Monday, September 21st

Please have it to the road Sunday night. We pick up throughout the whole town. If you don't have it out by the time we come around, you will have to wait until the next month. **Please refer to our guidelines on our website at elockport.gov under highway department.**

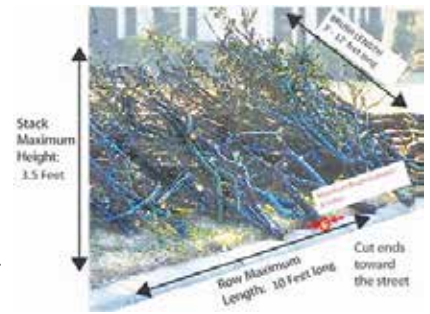
Refuse/Recycling: Please have your garbage and recycling out by 6 am. If it isn't picked up by 2 pm, call the highway clerk at 716-439-9522. Please remember you must use the town issued garbage tote. No other tote will be emptied.

Bags of Garbage: If you have bags which are over forty pounds, Modern will pick them up during large item pick up week. If they are less than forty pounds, you will need to purchase stickers from town clerk's office for \$5 each.

Bulk Pick Up: *Modern will pick up 4 large items during the first full week of each month.* If they don't take it with the regular garbage truck, please be patient and they will come back with another truck. This includes any carpet/flooring/wood planks you may have.

Hazardous Materials: If you have anything hazardous and are unsure of how to dispose of it, please call Hazman at 716-998-8073.

Road Work: As the weather is getting warmer, please be cautious when our crews are milling/paving. We ask that you obey flagmen and detour signs to ensure their safety. Visit our Facebook page, website (elockport.gov), or watch the LED sign at Town Hall for roadwork updates.
